



## Coupon Policy

As a customer focused retailer, White's Foodliner encourages the use of coupons by our customers in our retail stores, in accordance with the following guidelines and limits.

- Manufacturer coupons (Cents off)
- Free merchandise (or manufacturers Buy-One-Get-One-Free)coupons
- Store coupons
- E-Coupons
- White's Foodliner only accepts coupons for merchandise we sell.
- Coupons should have an expiration date and be presented within the valid dates. White's Foodliner will not accept expired coupons.
- Internet coupons should be legible and say "Manufacturer Coupon."  
There should be a valid remit address for the manufacturer and a scannable bar code.
- Internet coupons not to exceed 75% of the value of the item.
- Only one coupon per item is permitted.
- Layering or stacking of coupons is not allowed.
- Sales tax must be paid for any Buy One Get One Free coupon offers, as required by applicable state laws. The coupon amount must be reduced if it exceeds the value of the item. (For example, a \$5.00 coupon for a \$4.99 item will result in a \$4.99 coupon value).
- White's Foodliner will accept manufacturer coupons for an item that is on sale.
- All valid coupons should be presented to the cashier at the time of checkout.
- Coupons and their face value cannot be exchanged for cash or gift cards.
- Competitor coupons are not accepted at White's Foodliner.
- White's Foodliner will double coupon value up to and including \$.50. (For example, a \$.75 coupon will increase by \$.25 for a \$1.00 total).

Any coupon offer not covered in these guidelines will be accepted at the discretion of White's Foodliner management.
